

Visa Approved Security Assessors (SA) List

Last Updated: 6 April 2020

Effective immediately, Visa no longer manages a security assessor program for its security programs.

Defined program participants that are required to validate compliance to one of the following Visa security programs; must use an assessor listed on the PCI SSC Assessor website.
